EDUCATION SERVICE GI BILL PROGRAMS

Dear GI Bill® Partner,

On June 1, 2022, COVID-19 legislation that permits your students to receive the Monthly Housing Allowance (MHA) at the resident (in person) rate, while taking approved courses converted to online training due to COVID-19 will end. Our records indicate that your institution has students enrolled in converted courses for terms that span June 1, 2022.

If your institution is operating in an unapproved modality, due to the COVID-19 pandemic, you must return to the approved modality before COVID-19 provisions were effective. **Returning to your approved modality must occur on or before June 2, 2022.**

How will this impact GI Bill Students?

VA realizes this transition could pose a hardship to those students who are mid-term. To help mitigate any negative impact to students, **VA will continue to pay students, in terms that span June 1, 2022, at the resident (in-person) rate through the end of the month or term, whichever occurs sooner.** However, students enrolling for courses beginning after June 1, 2022, will need to enroll in approved resident (in person) classes to continue receiving their MHA at the resident rate. Otherwise, they will receive the online rate, which is half the national average.
