HOW TO SET UP YOUR NEW VOICEMAIL

1. Call Voicemail (Same Extension as before) or Press your Voicemail button (if applicable)
2. When prompted enter the default Security Code- 0000
3. You will be guided through the setup process to record your name, greeting and set a new security code. Wait for system to prompt you to save your setup option before you hang up.

It is recommended that you include your name and department in your outgoing greetings. Below is a sample message for your convenience.

“You have reached (your name) in the (your department) at Los Angeles Southwest College. I either away from my desk or another call, however, your call is important. Please leave a brief message including your name and call back number and I will return your call before end of the day. Thank you and have a nice day!”

To utilize voicemail as an effective means of communication, it is important to be succinct when recording your personal greeting and when leaving a message in another mailbox. Proper use of the telephone and voicemail system can result in a more productive working environment

When recording a greeting, always include the following:

- Establish a standard greeting for your office for example: “Hello, you have reached
- Your name
- Department/office
- Location: at Los Angeles Southwest College
- Who to call for immediate assistance (if applicable)
- Add extended leaves or vacation dates

CHECK MESSAGES

WHEN CALLING FROM YOUR EXTENSION:

Dial 5400 or press the VM key, enter security code, if any, and follow the instructions.

WHEN CALLING FROM OUTSIDE OF THE OFFICE

Dial outside access (323) 241-5400 or (323) 241-5225. Listen to the greeting message, “Thank you for calling Los Angeles Southwest College ...,” and wait for the menu. Press 9 and your extension number and you will be sent to the main menu of the voice mail system. Follow the instructions.

Guidelines

Telephone and Voicemail Etiquette

A phone conversation is usually the first contact a person has with Los Angeles Southwest College. Students and individuals seeking information are trying to access our college, and anything we can do to make their interaction with us warm and sensitive will go a long way in projecting a “Helping” image.

Fundamental Rules

- Please pick up the phone no later than the fourth (4th) ring. Place current caller on hold if necessary, to answer in-coming call informing initial caller that they are being placed on hold momentarily.
- Answer the phone with name and department/division office and ask “How can I help you?”
- Offer a pleasant greeting
- Upon completion of your interaction with the caller, ask the caller “Have I assisted you with your issue,” or before transferring the call “is there anything else I can I assist you with before I transfer the call?”
- Before transferring the call, ensure that the person/department that the call is being transferred to is in the office. If the person/department is not available direct them to leave a voicemail on the requested person’s/department’s number.

Taking Messages

A message should always give the caller’s name, company, phone number and, if necessary, the best time to return the call. Failure to return calls is the most common complaints in business.

Speakerphone Etiquette

Always ask permission of the other person before talking to them on the speakerphone and always identify the other people in the room.

Transferring Calls

When transferring calls observe the following:

- Transfer calls only if you are certain that you cannot help the caller and reasonably sure the person to whom the caller is being transferred can help the caller.
- Give an explanation of why the call is being transferred.
- Always give the caller the phone number and name (department/or person) of the area they are being transferred to.
- Stay on the line until someone answers whenever possible to provide smooth transition for caller.
- If the caller seems annoyed about being transferred, suggest a call back rather than risk poor customer service. The caller may have been bounced from one wrong number to another several times, before reaching you.

Leaving a Voicemail Message

When leaving a voicemail message consider the following:

- Identify yourself and the subject matter
- Keep messages brief and address only one or two topics
- Keep contents of the voicemail appropriate for business
- Always state the date and time
- Always leave a call back number and repeat numbers slowly.
- Sign off positively.
- Don’t ignore messages, reply promptly.
- Requests for information that are complete and concise allow the recipient to quickly and accurately respond to voicemail.

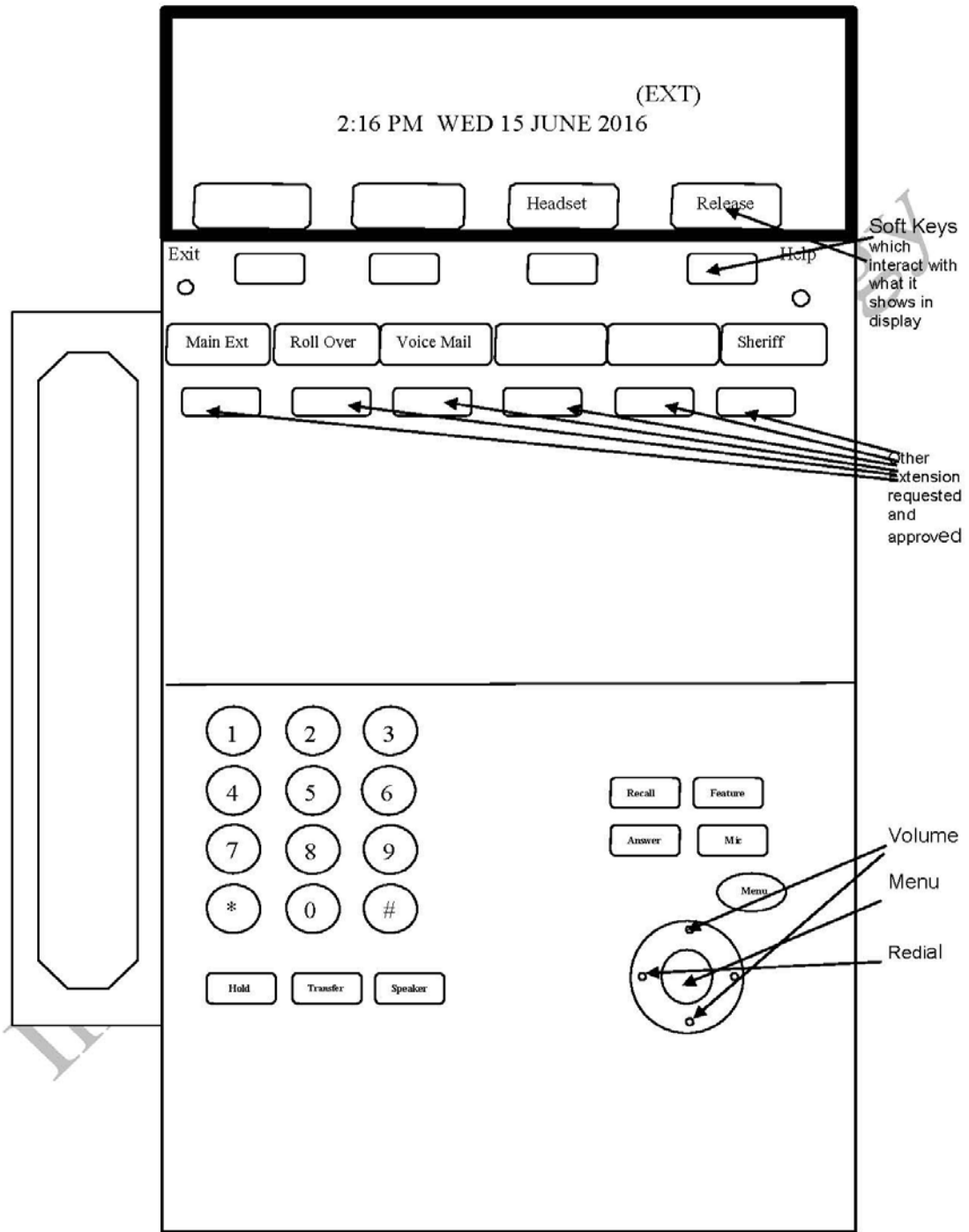

Quick Reference Sheet on the new NEC DT700 Series phones

Main Ext

Main number assigned to the phone, either referring to an employee or department

Roll Over

The calls would go to this number in case the main extension is in use. You cannot receive calls on the number from outside callers.

Voice Mail

Pressing this button would allow you to access your voice mailbox.

Sheriff

Pressing this button would connect you to the Sheriff's station at the campus

Volume/Display Control

All volume and display controls are done through the directional circle located on the lower right side of phone. This controls the speaker, display, ringer, and handset.

Speaker

To place a speakerphone (hands-free) call, Press **SPEAKER** key. In order for you to speak hands-free your MIC light must be lit. Press **MIC** key to turn MIC On/Off.

To Originate an Outside Call

Lift handset or press the **Speaker** key, and receive a dial tone.
Dial 9 and desired telephone number

To Originate an Internal Call

Lift Handset or press the **Speaker** key
Receive dial tone
Dial desired station

Transfer a Call

While on a call
Press **Transfer** key
Dial desired station number. Display indicates digits dialed.
Announce call or simply hang up. If the party does not answer it will go to voicemail. (if the user has voicemail)
If voicemail answers press the **DISC soft key to drop voicemail and return to caller.

Conference Calling

Lift Handset
Dial 9+Number or dial extension and Establish 1st call
Press **TRANSFER**.
Dial 9 + number or dial extension, establish 2nd call,
(If voicemail answers you can press the **DISC** soft key and return to first call).
Press **CONF soft key** to connect all parties.

Redial (Last Number Redial)

Lift Handset or press **Speaker** key
Press **Redial**, located on the left side of the circle
Continue to press redial until the number you want to call is displayed.
Press the *****key to dial the number displayed.

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Soft Key Features

Quick Transfer to Voicemail (VTMF): Allows you to transfer a call directly to a user's voicemail. With caller on the line press Transfer, dial extension and press the VMTRF soft key and hang up immediately.

HSET (HEADSET):

Allows the user to go off and on hook when using the headset. When phone rings press headset key to answer call via your headset, to hang up press headset key again.

RLS (RELEASE):

Allows the user to release from the current call when using the headset, without waiting for the other party to hang up.



Peek: When you're on the phone and another call comes into your second line you can press the peek soft key to see who is calling. This feature is not available at this time.

VM: means that you have voice mail.



means that you have missed calls.
