  - Make-up of the 21<sup>st</sup> Century Workforce
    - The emerging worker (typically 22 years of age or younger, preparing for their first full-time employment)
    - The transitional worker ( individuals moving from one career to another for a variety of reasons)
    - The entrepreneurial worker (owners and operators of small to medium-size business)
    - The incumbent worker (currently employed and needing additional training for (job security) and/or promotional opportunity.
  - 21<sup>st</sup> Century Curriculum Challenges Facing Community Colleges
    - Reformulating the content of their workforce development curriculum
    - Expanding teaching strategies to serve diverse populations of learners
    - Establishing program review and curriculum development processes that are locally-based, globally-informed and linked to college's mission statement and strategic goals; and
    - Implementing HRD and OD plans that (a) improve the employment prospects of adults, youth and dislocated workers and (b) respond to federal, state and local initiatives (i.e., SCANS Report, CCC 2006 System-wide Strategic Plan, et.).

      - Develop new programs, certificates and services that provide a bridge to baccalaureate-granting institutions of higher education;
      - Responding to the needs of local employers:
      - Facilitating the College's role in regional economic development; and
