First quarter NCLEX-RN Result	Introduction by Ms. McClellan. First day was yesterday 11/18/19. Welcomed by all staff present. In lab 5 days a week to assist faculty, also for TEAS and remediation New students orientation tomorrow 11/19/19 from 1000 – 1700 in RM NPR 125 SOCTE. Classes start Feb 2020 NCLEX-RN first quarter Result is 57%. This places the school under close observation. The school is trying her best to ensure student success but the students do not utilize the resources provided for their success. The school pays for U-WORLD and Hurst reviews to alleviate financial burden on the students (about \$405/student) – still poor student usage. Students pay for Kaplan. NCLEX exam by State Board has test items more on critical/reflective thinking – Analysis, Synthesis, Evaluation. Hurst is content based and Kaplan is more of test taking strategy, and U-WORLD is higher testing strategy. Cohort of May 2019 exam -57% and > 50% took exam after 3 months, so may not qualify for \$500 incentive

A team is coming to audit the college, looking for areas to cut. LASC is asking LACCD, the district, to forgive/forfeit the debt- this has been on since 2008 – debt (cost of running the college is over expected budget)</p> <p>Instructor to teach assigned classes Monday and Tuesday and clinical assignment reassigned so instructor can be in the skills lab for 17 hours. The present 2 faculty in skills lab to take over clinical assignment of the faculty.</p>
